

HOUSING AND TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Campus Housing

University of Pennsylvania offers economic housing on campus, in air-conditioned high-rise residence halls, multi-occupancy suites with private bedrooms and shared living spaces (sitting room and bathroom) at a rate of \$68.00 plus tax per person per night. A limited number of shared bedrooms at \$53.00 plus tax per person per night will be available. Meals are available next door, at 1920 Commons, and may be purchased in advance with housing reservation: \$6.40 for each breakfast and \$13.25 for each dinner. Lunch is included with the meeting registration fee.

Transportation

The Philadelphia area is serviced by major airlines flying into Philadelphia International Airport, by Amtrak Rail at the 30th Street Station (20 min walk from the campus) and other regional train systems. SEPTA offers high speed rail line (R1) from the airport to University City where the campus is located as well as to 30th Street Station.
