## NOMINATION for 2004 VIKTOR HAMBURGER OUTSTANDING EDUCATOR PRIZE

Objective: Established in 2002 by the Board of Directors and sponsored by the Professional Development and Education Committee of the Society for Developmental Biology, this award recognizes a individuals who have made outstanding contributions to developmental biology education.

Eligibility: a nominee must have made outstanding contributions to education in developmental biology. Contributions will be construed in the broadest context and may include teaching at any level; training professionals; organizing and administrating programs; integrating developmental biology into our educational system; or disseminating reliable information to professional members, to prospective developmental biologists, to students in other fields, or to the general public. Candidates are not required to be SDB members but must be nominated at least by two SDB members. Prize recipient must be able to deliver a lecture at the Education Symposium at the SDB Annual Meeting.

Selection: An Awards Committee of SDB Directors and members chaired by President-elect (Judith Kimble for 2004 award) will consider all nominations and will make recommendations to the SDB Board of Directors who will make the final selection.

Prizes: A check in the amount of $\$ 1000$ and an award will be presented to the winner at the Education Symposium of the SDB $63{ }^{\text {rd }}$ Annual Meeting (University of Calgary, Calgary, Alberta, Canada, July 24 July 28, 2004). The winner will be invited to attend the annual meeting, with travel and housing paid for by SDB, and the meeting registration fee will be waived.
