- 2) Click "register" (if you are a first time user) on the top toolbar and enter required information. You will receive an email confirming registration and the password. If you are already a registered user, log in as you would to submit a manuscript. Click "Send Username/Password" if you have forgotten your login info.
- 3) Log in at EES as instructed by the email.
- 4) Click "Submit New Manuscript" on the top toolbar and open "Choose Article Type" drop-down box on the bottom of the page.
- 5) Select "SDB cover submission-Student" or "SDB cover submission-Postdoc" according to your category.
- 6) Click "Next" and enter the title of your figure in "Full Title" box.
- 7) Skip the steps for "Add/Edit/Remove Authors" and "Select Classifications."
- 8) **Under "Enter Comments" please type in your SDB member number.** If you need your member number, call 301-634-7815 or email sdb@sdbonline.org.
- 9) Skip "Request Editor."
- 10) Go to "Attach Files" and attach your figure. Read the instructions in **blue** on the bottom of this page before uploading the file.
- 11) Click "Next" and then "Build PDF for My Approval." Click "Submissions Waiting for Author's Approval" and under the "Action Links" you can view and approve your submission.
